Remarks for the Day of the Examination

Admission on Recommendation: Examination held at University of Tsukuba – Tsukuba Campus

1. Meeting Time and Place on the examination day

Examination Date: Friday, 3 July / Monday, 6 July 2026

Connection Start Time: from 13:30 on 3 July or 9:30 on 6 July (detailed schedule notified later)

2. Oral Examination

On the examination day, a teleconference system will be used. Applicants are expected to arrange an appropriate environment to take the examination.

Details for connection will be announced at a later stage. In case of emergency, if you wish to contact us, please use a phone call from a landline or mobile phone.

NOTE: If any emergency or problem arises during the examination, we will handle it using phone calls. Please inform the Academic Service Office for the Systems and Information Engineering Area of your phone number in advance and ensure that you will be ready to take our call on the examination day if required.

The examinee is expected to deliver a presentation of his/her research achievements, research plan, and career plan using presentation slides. A question and answer session is scheduled after the presentation.

Please prepare your presentation taking account of the time allocation given below.

3. Confirming Your Identity

To confirm your identity, we will check your Reference Card and the Photo Sheet we have, but we may ask you to show us your passport and/or photo ID card. Please have them ready in case the examiners ask for it. On the examination day, please make yourself look like you on the photo of your Reference Card as closely as you can (e.g. clothing, hairstyle, glasses, etc.) so that the examiners can identify you correctly.

NOTE: If the examinee's identity cannot be confirmed, the examination will not be conducted.

To ensure a smooth implementation of the examination, please keep in mind:

1. Follow the instructions from the examiners during the examination.
2. Make an oral pledge not to cheat to the examiner at the start of the examination.

3. Ensure you are alone during the examination and avoid suspicious behaviors.

4. Keep looking at the camera while you speak so that your face is always clearly visible during the examination.

Looking away from the camera unnaturally will be considered evidence of cheating.
